## BEJEWELED FELT TREE ORNAMENTwith Heather Donohue

## SUPPLY LIST

- Felt, 19x12" sheet (wool or wool-blend, if possible)
- Sequins, assorted colors and sizes. Small cup, large cup, and novelty shapes.
- Seed beads
- (Optional) Tiny jingle bells; larger beads
- One yard of narrow metallic trim or ricrac
- Beading needles (need to be narrow enough to pass through seed beads, length not important.)
- Needle threader tool (beading needles are tricky to thread without one)
- All-purpose needle (for sewing trim in place. It can be done with a beading needle, but is easier to thread and work with).
- Thread in colors to compliment project.
  - A color for sewing the tree (stitches will be visible, and a stitch color that stands out is fun!)
  - A color for sewing the trim to the tree (similar color to trim)
  - o At least one color for sewing beads and sequins in place
- · Metallic cording, thread, or thin ribbon of choice to hang the ornament
- Scissors for cutting felt and snipping thread
- 4x4" scrap of corrugated cardboard (goes inside project for structure)
- Polyfill or similar to stuff the tree
- (Optional) Poking stick, pencil, or similar to get stuffing placed just so
- (Optional) Fine permanent marker to sign and date the bottom of your work
